



## APPLICATION TO WORK AT THE POLLS

Under Rhode Island General Law 17-11-12, in order to work the polls an individual must be:

- A registered voter in Rhode Island
- Able to read the Constitution of the state in English
- Able to write his/her own name

**NOTICE:** Under R.I.G.L. §17-11-15 and §17-11-12 you are ineligible to work as a pollworker if you are a candidate for public office, or if you have been convicted, found guilty, pleaded guilty or nolo contendere, or placed on a deferred or suspended sentence, or on probation, for any crime which involves moral turpitude or which constitutes a violation of any of the election or caucus laws of this or any other state. **Federal, State, and Municipal employees are prohibited from working as pollworkers in a primary election.** (R.I.G.L 17-15-14)
